### **FINANCIAL UPDATE**

The May Revenue for our Parish was \$26,649.01 and year to date was \$146,252.21. The May Expenses were \$25,761.57 and year to date: \$114,463.95. Leaving us with a surplus of \$887.44 for the month of May and \$31,788.26 for the year to date. The income includes monthly dividend funds from our investments of approximately \$6,600 per month. Please note: The income surplus will be greatly depleted in June when funds from Glebe property sales are transferred to our investments.
