MONDAY'S SOLAR ECLIPSE

The Solar Eclipse is this Monday beginning about 2:15 P.M. Atlantic Time.

DO NOT LOOK DIRECTLY AT THE ECLIPSE, it can blind you.

Sunglasses are not enough to protect your eyes. There are proper glasses you can buy if you want to look directly at the Eclipse.

"Just because 80 per cent of the sun is missing, 20 per cent of the sun is there. You only need a fraction of a percent of the sun to be visible to generate eye damage," astronomer Paul Delaney told CBC News.
